Notebook, Calculator, Pencils, erasers Sun Protection, Sun Glasses & Sun Hat Waterproof Duffel or Day Pack to take gear on boats Foul Weather Gear, Boots & Hat for inclement weather Extra Clothing – it can be cold here on the water PFD –WBS will provide PFDs, but you may bring your own
