It is very helpful for students to bring tools along to reduce wait time and keep work moving. The instructor will bring an assortment of tools with him. All materials, supplies, and tools will be provided either by the teacher or the student. The list developed prior to class that will enable the student to work effectively on his/her boat throughout the week. It is suggested that you bring the following tools with you if you have them available. While it is not necessary you may purchase them. The suggested tool list includes:

- X-Acto saw w/ handle (available at AC Moore, Michaels, Dick Blick, hardware stores)
- X-Acto miter box (available at AC Moore, Michaels, Dick Blick, hardware stores)
- X-Acto # 1 Precision Knife With 5, # 11 Blades (available at AC Moore, Michaels, Dick Blick, hardware stores)
- Small Block Plane (hardware store, Lowes, Home Depot)
- Precision screw driver set
- 12' tape measure
- 6" or 12" combination square
- Assorted files
- Scratch awl
- Pliers (small version)
- Scissors
- Assorted small clamps (one can never have enough clamps)
- Small hammer

REMEMBER: A list of materials and supplies will be generated for each student and his/her boat. This may customize the list above.

IMPORTANT: Because we will be customizing the course for each particular student and boat the list may vary. The variables will be worked out with each student prior to arrival.
