The WoodenBoat School shop is very well supplied, however there may be specialty items needed for this course that may be needed. *Please feel free to bring your favorite tools and supplies*. Antique shops and old tool stores are found throughout downeast Maine and may provide a good source for needed tools.

## **RECOMMENDED TOOLS:**

Personal safety gear such as work clothes, knee pads if needed, goggles and hearing protection. Dust masks and disposable gloves will be provided.

## Tool box or bag with the following:

- Hand planes such as block planes, bench planes, rabbet and bullnose planes, spoke shave, chisel set, sharpening stones
- Hand saw, Japanese pull saws, bit brace with driver bits, impact screw extractor, drill screw extractors, files and rasps, drill bits including carbide tipped forstner bits, small cobalt drill bits (7/64" thru 3/16"), counter sink bits, bung cutters
- Measuring tape, combination square, bevel gauge, flexible angle finders, compass dividers, pencils and Sharpies.
