A typical Introduction to Boatbuilding class starts on Sunday evenings with a brief introduction and an overview of the week ahead. Monday through Friday you'll working in the shop from 8 am until around 5 pm. Depending on how the work is progressing, there might be an evening spent in the shop as well. Saturday is a half-day, focusing on the steps involved in finishing up the boat we've built.
