

Tool list:

Pencil

Tape measure (At least 16')

Japanese Beading Saw (With "Woodpecker" tooth if possible)

9" Shinto Rasp

Standard Block Plane (Standard or Low – Whatever best fits your hand)

Contour Scraper

5" Round Flex hand sanding pad

Optional:

Mini square

Arrow 50 Hand Stapel Gun

Mini Trim Plane

Blade sharpener or stone

Safety equipment:

Approved Respirator (like a 3M half facepiece 6001)

Dust Mist Filter

Organic Vapor Filter

Clothes:

Something you don't mind getting epoxy and varnish on...

Old work clothes or Apron

Shoes that you don't mind getting epoxy/varnish on.

Gauntlets if you have short sleeves. (We can bring some to offer.)

(Epoxy is known to have a 5' jumping radius. Just kidding. But known to show up on clothes mysteriously.)

Please note, some people are unknowingly allergic to certain cedars and/or epoxy near or on the skin or breathing the dust/fumes, and do not know until a day or two into the project.

So please do wear lightweight long sleeves and leg coverings to start when epoxying & varnishing if you have never experience being near these chemicals before. We will be using SystemThree's SilverTip marine epoxy, and Epifanes: Gloss Varnish, EZ-Flow, Thinner, and Matte Varnish. Then if you wish to go to shorter sleeves/pants, please be aware that you do not want this on your skin, so bring gauntlets and an apron... these liquids are a carcinogen. It's nice to have a ball cap when sanding with an orbital sander.
