Goggles or safety glasses Ear protection 12" combination Square 13oz hammer Back Saw or Japanese dozuki saw ½", ¾" and 1" chisels Block plane. This is a tool we'll use a lot and it's nice to have a good one. We sell nice Melbourne tools in the store. 16' tape 6" steal pocket rule Pencils, pen and notebook Flathead and Phillips screwdrivers
