| Quality Pencil compass | Wooden mallet |
| Low-angle block plane (12 degrees) | Rabbet plane |
| Spokeshave | Respirator |
| Long handled wood chisels ($\frac{3}{4}$ "-1") | Dividers |
| Small claw hammer | Notebook and/or camera (helpful for taking notes) |
| Small ball peen hammer | Safety glasses & Hearing protection |
| Assorted screwdrivers | Work Clothes & closed toed footwear |
