Goggles or safety glasses

Ear protection

12" combination Square

13oz hammer

Back Saw or Japanese dozuki saw

1/2", 3/4" and 1" chisels

Block plane. This is a tool we'll use a lot and it's nice to have a good one. Look at the Lie-Nielsen, Veritas from Lee Valley, or Jorgensen models. \ a good hand plane from a

16' tape

6" steal pocket rule
