Throughout the workshop we will shoot in a wide range of locations and weather conditions. Please bring clothes and footwear for good weather and bad, indoors and on the water. Summer in Maine can bring all the weather conditions imaginable. Sometimes the most engaging photographs come from dramatic weather. We will do our best to stay dry and comfortable, but spray, drizzle and fog are par for the course. Students are responsible for keeping their own gear safe.

Students are required to bring a DSLR camera (sorry, no point and shoots for this week), useful lenses, all associated gear like batteries, chargers, tripods and enough memory cards to shoot for multiple days.

For editing, a laptop or appropriate tablet with your preferred editing software is required. There are numerous software options for editing and I am happy to work with each student's preference individually. Don't forget the necessary cables.

Friday afternoon and most of Saturday will be on the water. Personal flotation devices (PFDs) will be provided. If you have your own PFD that you wear comfortably, I recommend you bring it too. If you're prone to seasickness, remember the nausea patches!

Food for this course is not provided. Students will need to bring their own food and beverages for the day.

There will be time to explore the WoodenBoat campus between sessions and the location provides endless photography opportunities. Bring any extra gear you would like for landscape and wildlife photography. Sunsets and star photography on the waterfront make incredible photos!
